Dear UJC Members and friends,

I'm pleased to send you the Shorashim 2010-2011 registration forms. To our returning Shorashim families I can only say that we are looking forward to a great year. If your family is new to Shorashim, I would like to thank you for joining us and I know that you will feel part of the Shorashim community very soon.

Shorashim is a special place that brings together UJC members and non-members. We all meet at Shorashim every Sunday to share Jewish experiences and study. This coming year we will again offer a full range of activities. Students ages 4 to 12 will participate in Judaica and Hebrew classes, and post-Bar/Bat Mitzvah students will be eligible for our Madrichim (Teacher Assistants program). The B'nai Mitzvah Class begun last year will once again be offered to help more fully prepare students for this important rite of passage. And of course, there will be Bagels and Binah, offering adults an opportunity to learn, discuss, and nosh.

Because the High Holidays fall early in the secular calendar this year, the first session of Shorashim will be Sunday, September 26. In order to help prepare for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur, we will be sending age appropriate materials to each registered family so that parents and children can review and learn about the holidays together. The Shorashim calendar for the year is attached to this letter.

Over the years, Shorashim has provided a wonderful community within The UJC for both children and parents. I hope that you will continue to share your enthusiasm about Shorashim with others and help us recruit new students and families to the program.

PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTION STATEMENT

This statement sets out The United Jewish Congregation of Hong Kong Hebrew & Religious School's ("Shorashim") policy and practices in relation to the collection of personal data from a parent and/or guardian (hereinafter collectively referred to as a "Parent") for or in relation to the purposes set out hereunder and the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (the "Ordinance").

From time to time, it may be necessary for a Parent to supply Shorashim with personal data (which data may relate to the Parent himself/herself or his/her child(ren)) in connection with the attendance of his/her child(ren) at Shorashim.

Failure to supply the requested personal data may result in delay or inability of Shorashim in processing the child(ren)'s registration.

The purposes for which data relating to a Parent and/or his/her child(ren) may be used are as follows:-

- establishing the identity and educational objectives of a Parent
- facilitating the best learning experience possible for the student
- meeting the requirements, including the requirement to make disclosure, under of any law, rules, regulations or codes binding on the Company and/or
- for purposes relating or incidental thereto

Data held by the Shorashim relating to a Parent and/or his/her child(ren) will be kept confidential but the Shorashim may provide, transfer, disclose or exchange such personal data to:-

- any other person under a duty of confidentiality to Shorashim who/which has undertaken to keep such information confidential
- any legal, accounting or professional person, firm or body and
- any government bodies, law enforcement or other regulatory authorities and corporation under any applicable law, rules or regulations

A Parent may be entitled under the Ordinance to request access to or to request the correction of any data supplied by him/her, in the manner and subject to the limitations prescribed therein.

In accordance with the terms of the Ordinance, Shorashim has the right to charge a reasonable fee for the processing of any data access request.
